Preamble

In the context of the Cooperative Health Insurance Council's awareness of its role, and in achieving the Council's strategic objectives related to organizing billing codes for the health insurance market, and taking into account the public interest by implementing the billing system in parallel with the activation of the **nphies** platform, some special coding groups have been updated In billing, as will be clarified in this directive.

Objective of this Policy Directive

This directive aims to inform Heath Insurance market participants of the application of the billing coding system in **nphies** platform and communicates the updates on medical standards that have a direct relationship to the application of the billing system.

The directive also requires that the standards to be applied immediately upon release of this directive and it will expires on December 17, 2020.

The revisions to the clinical standards codes

Based on the implementation of the billing system within **nphies** platform, the following medical standards should be updated as follows:
